

Reduce Your Risk of Lung Cancer

While the number of cases and the number of deaths from lung cancer have declined dramatically over the past decade, lung cancer is still the leading cause of cancer deaths in the United States in both men and women. According to the American Cancer Society, more people die of lung cancer in a year than from breast, prostate and colon cancer combined; however, there are several ways to reduce your risk of lung cancer.

AN OUNCE OF PREVENTION ...

Approximately 85% of all lung cancer occurs in people who smoke. So it stands to reason that one of the best ways to reduce your risk of getting lung cancer is to never begin smoking, or to stop smoking as soon as possible. Tobacco in all forms increases your risk of various types of cancer; chief among them is lung cancer. There are many programs to assist with smoking cessation. Discuss these options with your doctor to determine which method is best for you.

EARLY DETECTION SAVES LIVES

Although there have been some real advances in the treatment of lung cancer, the average five-year survival rate for lung cancer in the U.S. is only 18.6%, <u>unless it is detected early</u>, according to the American Lung Association. However, if the disease is detected early, while it is still localized within the lungs, the five-year survival rate soars to 56%. So your chances of surviving lung cancer are three times greater when it is detected early.

Unfortunately, only about 15% of all lung cancer cases are diagnosed at an early stage. Why? Because often in the early stages there are no real symptoms. That is one of the reasons why regular screenings are so important - especially if you are a current smoker or if you have ever been a heavy smoker for longer than 15 to 20 years.

Through the use of low-dose spiral CT scans of the chest, lung cancer can often be detected in its early stages before it becomes incurable, or even before a patient is showing symptoms. This type of screening can detect early stage cancers that cannot be seen on traditional chest X-rays. Screening is recommended for people with a history of heavy smoking, defined as 30 pack years or more. A pack year

means smoking an average of one pack of cigarettes per day for one year (for example: one pack per day for 30 years or two packs per day for 15 years). Check with your physician to see if you could benefit from a CT lung scan.

IMPROVEMENTS IN THE TREATMENT OF LUNG CANCER

Many advances in the treatment of lung cancer have occurred in the past decade, including the development of medications known as targeted therapies, which interfere with certain processes that cancer cells use to grow and spread, and immunotherapies, a type of targeted therapy that boosts the body's immune system to fight cancer. These drugs have given oncologists many more options in treating lung cancer and have made treatment more effective and safer for patients.

LUNG CANCER RESEARCH INVESTIGATES MANY POSSIBILITIES

Many clinical trials are looking at newer combinations of chemotherapy drugs to determine which are the most effective. These are especially important for older patients who may have other health problems, and doctors are studying these combinations to discover if treatment outcomes can be further improved. Sometimes, chemotherapy is also being used in combination with some targeted therapies and has been shown to improve survival rates.

There is still much research needed to develop even more effective treatments for lung cancer; however, today many more people are surviving the disease than ever before.

Gum Disease a Risk Factor for Heart Disease?



ver the past number of years, more and more research studies have been discussing the possible link between periodontal disease (gum and jaw bone disease) and other significant medical conditions. Periodontal disease includes a number of conditions ranging from Gingivitis (swollen gums) to Periodontitis (the loss of jaw bone that can lead to tooth loss). Some of the studies have started to link periodontal disease to more broad medical issues such as cardiovascular and pulmonary diseases.

A recent study reported in the European Journal of Preventive Cardiology (April 9, 2014) discussed periodontal disease as a possible risk factor for cardiovascular disease. The article summarized a very large study of patients (15,828 patients) from 39 countries with cardiac disease. It is believed to be the largest known study evaluating gum disease in patients with coronary disease.

The study reported more risk factors and biological indicators for cardiovascular disease with patients demonstrating increased tooth loss and bleeding gums. In short, the report suggests that there may be a link between periodontal disease and coronary disease. At this point, it has not been proven that there is a direct "cause and effect" relationship between the 2 diseases. Many studies have demonstrated a relationship between gum and heart illnesses.

What Can You Do?

It is important to continually (once or twice a year) see your dentist or periodontist for a complete periodontal evaluation. This painless examination includes measuring around the teeth to determine if the gums are inflamed or if jaw bone loss is occurring. A recent, complete set of dental x-rays are also used to help determine if the disease is present. A prominent national study demonstrated that gum disease is much more common than we used to believe. It has been shown that over 50% of people over the age of 30 have some form of periodontal disease.

Should it be determined that you have periodontal disease, a variety of forms of treatment are available. Earlier forms of the disease may be treated with periodontal maintenance ("cleanings"). More advanced forms often are treated with conventional procedures or more recently LANAP (laser therapy). The overall goal of any periodontal therapy is to help maintain health, keep your teeth and hopefully prevent an increased risk for other medical issues such as cardiac disease.





Additionally, the use of tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs and some medications, such as some antidepressants, can also cause or worsen ED. Neurological conditions that can cause ED include Parkinson's disease and stroke. 

How Doctors Choose Surgeons

By David A. Goldman MD hen it's time to have an elective surgical procedure how would you choose a surgeon? Most people will ask friends and family, others may do their own internet research. When I needed a hernia repair, I did what all other doctors do – I asked another doctor. Not just any doctor, but in this case the residents who worked with all the doctors in the department of surgery. When a family member needed surgery, I called and spoke to one of the scrub nurses at the local surgery center. While top degrees and awards certainly contain value, there is not always a direct correlation with surgical skill. Scrub nurses, OR technicians, and residents are in unique positions to compare surgeons not on a one-time basis, but on an annual day-in day-out experience. Surgical representatives are often the best because they survey hundreds of doctors within a large geography (and yes, I have relied on the advice of surgical reps many times for my family members).

This is not to downplay the value of resumes, accolades, internet research, and word of mouth. If a personal associate of yours had an excellent experience with a surgeon, you should absolutely trust their opinion. In southern Florida, the population is continually changing, with new patients relocating here every day. In some cases you may not know whom to see for care. Remember that there are multiple sources available for you to check.

So what occurred in my situation? I selected a surgeon based on the advice of residents and fellows who worked with all general surgeons. I had minimal postoperative discomfort and was extremely satisfied with the end result. Of note, a colleague sought out a "renowned" surgeon for the same procedure and had significant pain. When he developed a hernia on the opposite side he saw my surgeon. He couldn't believe how much better the experience was.

In summary, there are many ways to select a surgeon. But, if in doubt, do what the doctors do.
